Application for Registration of a Brand

Information for Completing this Application:

- 1. A brand is a permanent identification mark of which the letters, numbers, and figures must each be four inches or more in length or diameter on the animal.
- 2. A Minnesota brand is only valid for use on the following animals: cattle, horses, sheep, and mules.
- 3. Keep brand images simple, so they are easier to read on the animal over time.
- 4. A brand design usually has two to three symbols or units to the image. A good reference for brand images is available on the website of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association:

- 5. Consider and indicate alternates to your first choice of brand image to avoid delay in issuance of a certificate.
- 6. Indicate all locations on animals that the brand will be applied to.
 - The thigh is included in the "hip" location.
 - Brands are not recordable on the necks or jaws of any animals.
 - Brands are not recordable on the side/ribs of horses.
- 7. Each location for your brand is considered a separate registration, requiring a \$10 fee. Brands used on sheep only are a flat \$10 fee, good for all locations.
- 8. Once the brand is confirmed and registered by the Board, a certificate will be mailed to you.

Cancellation or Abandonment:

Failure to renew a brand on or before the time specified on the certificate will be considered an absolute abandonment of the brand. The Board may not reissue a brand so abandoned except to the original owner upon proper application or, after a period of two years, to another applicant.

Brand Transfer:

Transfer of brands requires the filing of a legally executed Bill of Sale of the brand, together with the "Brand Registration Certificate" and a transfer fee of \$10.00. A "Bill of Sale" form is included on the back of your original certificate.
