

Exhibition Requirements for Chickens, Turkeys and Game Birds

Waterfowl, ratites and pigeons do not have any exhibition requirements; import requirements still apply

Identification

- All chickens, turkeys, and gamebirds at exhibitions, except baby poultry, must be individually identified with a leg or wing band with a number on the band. The band may also include other letters such as names/initials.
 - Hatching eggs and young poultry that are too small to band can be exhibited as a group if the Hatchery Permit number or National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) number is written on the cage, box or enclosure.



Poultry Testing Requirements

- All chickens, turkeys, gamebirds, and hatching eggs from these birds must originate from a hatchery or breeding flock that is NPIP Pullorum-Typhoid (PT) Clean or be negative to a pullorum-typhoid test within 90 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition.
 - Turkeys cannot be tested same day. Blood must be sent to an approved lab prior to sale.
- All chickens, turkeys, gamebirds, and hatching eggs from these birds must be accompanied by a certificate or test chart that shows compliance with the requirements above. Examples include: Statement of Origin for Poultry Exhibitions, pullorum-typhoid test report (Rapid Whole Blood Test Reporting Form or Laboratory Report), Hatchery Permit Card, NPIP VS FORM 9-2, NPIP VS FORM 9-3, and NPIP VS FORM 9-31*
- If a test chart is used to demonstrate compliance, the band number on the bird must match the test chart.

STATEMENT OF ORIGIN FOR POULTRY EXHIBITIONS

Statement of Origin forms are allowed at Minnesota exhibitions to show proof birds originated from a National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) hatchery. The NPIP status does not transfer to the exhibitor and does not prove current NPIP status with change of ownership.

In the State of Minnesota, all chickens, turkeys, game birds, and hatching eggs from these birds must meet the following requirements at exhibitions:

- Be individually identified with a leg or wing band with a number on the band. The band may also include other letters such as names/initials.
- Originate from a National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) classified Pullorum-Typhoid (PT) Clean hatchery or breeding flock; or be negative to a PT test within ninety (90) days prior to exhibition;
- Be accompanied by a certificate or test chart approved by the Minnesota Board of Animal Health to show compliance with these requirements.
- If a test chart is used to demonstrate compliance, the band number on the bird must match the test chart.
- All birds from another state must also meet Minnesota import requirements. Import requirements can be found on our Board of Animal Health import website: <https://www.mn.gov/bah/imports>
